Morning Arrival:

If you have a scheduled exam:

- Arrive to the cafeteria by 8:45 A.M. with your uniform (or Spirit Pass) and all items required to write the exam.
- Students will be called into the gym by exam starting ~ 9:15 A.M.

If you do not have a scheduled exam:

- Proceed to Room 305 for study hall.

Lunch:

FKCS has the cafeteria from 8:00 A.M – 9:30 A.M. and from 1:00 P.M. – 4:30 P.M. Students who finish their exam in the morning must either report to study hall or leave school property. This is to ensure the building is quiet and conducive to examinations. Students who have made prior arrangements with teachers may work with them on tutorials if this is agreed upon.

Two table rows on the south side of the cafeteria will be labeled for FKCS students to eat lunch between 11:30 -1:00 if needed. Please only use these tables as Fieldstone Day School will be using the rest of the cafeteria at this time

Hot lunch service will not be available during the examination period.

Afternoon Arrival:

If you have a scheduled exam:

- Arrive to the cafeteria between 1:10 and 1:15 P.M. with your uniform and all items required to write the exam.
- Students will be called into the gym by exam starting at ~ 1:15 P.M.

If you do not have a scheduled exam:

- Stay in the cafeteria for study hall.

Exam Length:

Exams have been designed to be 2 hours in length. English Language Learners and Student Success Plan students will have an additional hour to complete the examination if required.

Exam Rules and Procedures:

- Cell phones, smart watches or any internet enabled device must be checked in and turned off upon arrival to the gym.
- Once in the gym, students must be quiet and await instruction from the exam leader.
- If a student has a question or must use the washroom they must raise their hand and wait for an invigilator to come to them. Students must sign the washroom sign-in/out sheet as necessary.
- Once a student has completed their examination, they should remain quiet, raise their hand and wait for their exam to be collected.
- Students will be dismissed at the exam leader's discretion, usually at 2 or 3 exit points that will be outlined at the beginning of the examination.

Late Arrivals:

- Students are expected to show up early for their exams.
- Students who are over 1 hour late, **will not** be admitted to write their examinations and will put their credits in jeopardy.



Study Hall :

- 8:30 to 12:30 (Room 305) and 1:15 to 3:30 (Cafeteria). All students looking for a quiet place to study are welcome to attend. Students must use this space for independent study. Disruptive and/or unproductive students will be asked to leave.

Exam Review Day:

- Students are welcome to see their examinations and talk with their teachers about the examinations on Monday, January 27th from 8:30 – 12:00
